I've worked with web-development professionally for three years. My first project – at Informa Healthcare – consisted of developing project management tools for scanning 1.5 million pages of academic journals to be reissued online.

Subsequently, at Aardvark Media, I've worked with many different parts of web-development, from site maintenance (code as well as data) to development of new features, tests and automation of these.

In my spare time I have made experiences from creating personal websites in PHP and MySQL as well as a gallery site for the photography business PL-Photo. In the last couple of years I have volunteered in web-development for the international organisation BeWelcome, where I currently head the development team.
