

How-To: Crochet a Triangle

Larger triangle:



1st Round: Magic loop

2nd Round: 15xsc, slip stitch

3rd Round: 3ch, 4xdc in the sc's, 4xch, (don't skip any sc's) 5xdc in sc's, 4xch, 5xdc in sc's, 4xch, connect with slip stitch

4th Round: 3ch, 7xdc in dc's, 4xch, (don't skip any dc's), 9xdc in dc's, 4xch, 9xdc in dc's, 4xch, 2xdc in dc's, connect with slip stitch

Repeat as many times as you need to make it bigger. You mind need to add chains on the corners when it gets bigger.

Smaller more concise version of the same triangle:



1st Round: Magic loop

2nd Round: 9xsc, slip stitch

3rd Round: 2ch, 2xsc in the sc's, 2xch, (don't skip any sc's) 3xsc in sc's, 2xch, 3xsc in sc's, 2xch, connect with slp stitch

4th Round: 2ch, 4xsc in sc's, 2xch, (don't skip any dc's), 5xsc in sc's...etc...

Repeat as many times as you need to make it bigger.
