## How-To: Crochet a Triangle

## Larger triangle:


$1^{\text {st }}$ Round: Magic loop
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ Round: 15xsc, slip stitch
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Round: $3 \mathrm{ch}, 4 x d c$ in the sc's, $4 x c h$, (don't skip any sc's) $5 x d c$ in sc's, $4 x c h, 5 x d c$ in sc's, $4 x c h$, connect with slip stitch
$4^{\text {th }}$ Round: $3 \mathrm{ch}, 7 x d c$ in dc's, $4 x c h$, (don't skip any dc's), $9 x d c$ in dc's, $4 x c h, 9 x d c$ in $d c^{\prime} s, 4 x c h, 2 x d c$ in dc's, connect with slip stitch

Repeat as many times as you need to make it bigger. You mind need to add chains on the corners when it gets bigger.

## Smaller more concise version of the same triangle:


$1^{\text {st }}$ Round: Magic loop
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ Round: 9xsc, slip stitch
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Round: $2 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{xsc}$ in the $s c^{\prime} \mathrm{s}, 2 \mathrm{xch}$, (don't skip any $s c^{\prime} \mathrm{s}$ ) 3 xsc in sc 's, $2 x c h, 3 x s c$ in sc's, $2 x c h$, connect with slp stitch
$4^{\text {th }}$ Round: $2 \mathrm{ch}, 4 \mathrm{xsc}$ in $\mathrm{sc}^{\prime}$ s, 2 xch , (don't skip any dc's), 5 xsc in sc's...etc...
Repeat as many times as you need to make it bigger.
